Recipients of Zakat

1- Fuqara: people who are destitute and extremely needy to the extent they are forced to beg for their daily food rations.

2- Masakeen: People who are poor and who possess more than their basic needs but do not possess wealth equal to Nisaab.

3- Al-Amileen Alaiha: Working class people, have jobs, still not reaching Nisaab n struggling financially.

4- Al-Muallafati Qlubohum: Non-Muslims who deserve Zakah

5- Fir-Riqaab: Freeing necks, in todays practice: freeing oppressed prisoners whom we believe are held/captured wrongly.

6- Al-Ghaarimeen: persons who have a debt and do not possess any other wealth or goods with which they could repay that which they owe. It is conditional that this debt was not created for any forbidden/Haram purpose.

7- Fi Sabeel e Allah: Whatever comes to support the path of Almighty Allah, i.e. outreaching/Da'awah, building schools, building/establishing free dispensaries/hospitals, digging wells...etc.

8- Ibn As-Sabeel: helping travelers in need.

(Surah At-Toubah: 9 : 60)

Nisab:-

The amount of wealth/property, which makes one liable for giving Zakat is called Nisab.

- * It differs with different kind of wealth: Silver, Gold, arrigation lands, livestock. But we measure now a days (our wealth) with gold ONLY as silver lost its stability.
- * For Gold it is 7.5 Tula equivalent or more throughout the year long
- * **A Muslim possesses such amount, 7.5 Tula (75 grams), which is almost about \$8000.00 (Eight thousand dollars in cash) has to pay Zakah of 2.5% (out of wealth which is more than his basic needs).** (Surah al Baqarah: 2 : 219)
- * **Zakat cannot be given to the off-springs of Prophet Muhammad PBUH**, specifically, five bloodlines: From Hazrat Ali RA, his both elder brothers: Ja'far n Aqeel RA, and both sons of Abbas RA (uncle of Prophet PBUH): Abdullah n Fazl RA.
